

# WUSPBA Northern Branch Annual Report-2022

Annual General Meeting  
October 22, 2022

As we come out of the pandemic, the Northern Branch Board has continued to provide online solo competitions and monthly educational events, as well as welcoming back several of the “in-person” games that we had missed over the last couple of years.

Our Northern Branch Board had a new Vice President come on board in 2022. Joyce MacLaury (a side drummer in the MacIntosh Pipe Band) took over for Rob Boyd as Rob had to step down due to work commitments.

Erin Berta continued as President, while Suzan Karayel and Amy Johannssen switched positions, with Suzan now taking on the Treasurer position (in addition to her Chief Steward position), and Amy taking the position of Secretary.

Last year (2021) we started by focusing on WUSPBA's list of Recommended Piobaireachd for Grade 4 pipers and we continued this effort in 2022. We now have completed our goal of having instructional recordings for all of the WUSPBA recommended piobaireachd tunes available on Youtube for everyone to use. It has been noted that all of these tunes while good for the G4 competition, are also great tunes to learn and play for competitions at the higher grade levels. We are grateful for those who volunteered to help instruct and lead us through a tune each month. The Northern Branch would like to thank all of the featured presenters, piping instructors, adjudicators, and professional competitors from throughout the WUSPBA community, for the time that they took to prepare and present us these lasting contributions.

In addition to the “In the Zoom” Piobaireachd nights, the Northern Branch also organized and sponsored two Online Solo Contests, one in the Spring and one in the Fall.

All participants received (or will receive) custom made souvenir stickers as a thank you for their participation. (If you didn't receive your sticker, please let us know!) We were delighted to not only have support and participation from our local pipers and drummers, but also those from across the United States, and

worldwide. Thank you to Suzan Karayel for organizing these events, and to all of those who competed, Judged, and who help facilitate the zoom online competitions.
